

#### After two years of closures, camps are back in session; however, there is an immense need to fund safe, engaging and educational summer activities.

This type of programming provides basic necessities like meals, physical activity, education and social/emotional outlets to low-income children. Research shows that over the summer months, most youth lose an average of two months of grade-level equivalency in math, and low-income youth lose more than two months in reading achievement. Over time, summer learning loss contributes to a widening achievement gap between lower- and higher-income youth that results in lower high school graduation rates for low-income youth. COVID-19 has widened this gap between children and families who can and cannot afford summer camp.
